


Analysis of BA 3rd Year Students Feedback, 2021 - 2022 (No of respondents: 542)


















72% of the students have rated their interaction with the office staffs as excellent, 20% rated it as good, 6% rated it satisfactory and 2% have rated it poor.












Majority of the respondents feel that the Communication Skill of the teachers is excellent, 3% find it good and 1% of each rated the communication skill as satisfactory and poor.





Total of 542 students responded to the Feedback Form given to them to assess their overall experience with the College. In the initial years the students could not attend the classes offline due to Covid protocols.

The overall analysis of the data shows that the majority of the students are satisfied with the facilities provided by the institution, classroom teaching of the teachers, fairness of evaluation, relationship with the teachers and the coverage of syllabus.

Some areas like the usefulness of the teaching material, interaction or the approachability of the office staff, their relationship with the Principal has shown the room for improvement.
